### **ALLEGANY COVID-19 CASE COUNTS RISE TO 115 Five additional cases identified since Friday.**

CUMBERLAND, MD – The Allegheny County Health Department reports that cases of COVID-19 in Allegheny County have climbed to 115. The latest confirmed positives include one employee and also two family members of a second employee at a nursing home with previously identified cases.

Two additional cases include a female in her teens and a female in her 50s. These cases are community acquired and not connected to the nursing home outbreak.

As of today, a total of 867 Allegheny County residents have been tested for COVID-19. Of those, 712 were negative, 115 positive, and 40 are still pending.
