### **ACHD ANNOUNCES PFIZER COVID VACCINE BOOSTER CLINICS 9/30 AND 10/1 Individuals must meet eligibility requirements to receive a booster shot**

CUMBERLAND, MD – The Allegany County Health Department will offer booster shots of the *Pfizer* COVID vaccine at clinics on Thursday, September 30 and Friday, October 1 from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. in the gymnasium of Allegany College of Maryland. In order to obtain a booster shot, individuals must have received their second dose of the *Pfizer* vaccine between January and March 2021 and fit one of the following classifications:

- Age 65 or older
- Age 50–64 with underlying medical conditions
- Age 18–49 with underlying medical conditions at high risk of severe illness from COVID-19
- Age 18-64 at increased risk for COVID-19 exposure and transmission because of their occupation or location in an institutional setting

Only those who were initially vaccinated with the *Pfizer* COVID vaccine can get the *Pfizer* booster. Those who were vaccinated with Moderna or Johnson & Johnson cannot get the *Pfizer* booster shot.

Qualifying individuals can pre-register for an appointment at one of the booster clinics by visiting [health.maryland.gov/allegany](https://health.maryland.gov/allegany) and clicking on the “*Pfizer* COVID Booster Registration” link on the right-hand side of the page. Those over age 65 and those without internet access can attend the clinic on a walk-in basis, but pre-registration is preferred for anyone able to do so. *Pfizer* vaccine boosters may also be available from your local pharmacy, urgent care clinic, pediatric office or primary care provider if they carry the *Pfizer* COVID-19 vaccine.

As of September 28, 44.6% of Allegany County residents were fully vaccinated against COVID-19, compared to 64.3% of all Marylanders.

Drive-thru testing is offered at the Allegany County Fairgrounds, 11400 Moss Avenue, Cumberland, MD on Mondays from 2 to 7 p.m., and Wednesdays and Fridays from 8 a.m. to 2 p.m. No appointment is needed, but pre-registration is strongly encouraged to minimize wait times at the clinic. You can pre-register for testing by going to [health.maryland.gov/allegany](https://health.maryland.gov/allegany) and clicking on the pre-registration link under “COVID-19 Information” on the right side of the page.
