### ALLEGANY COVID-19 CASES UP BY 17 SINCE WEDNESDAY

CUMBERLAND, MD – The Allegheny County Health Department reports that 17 individuals have tested positive for COVID-19 since Wednesday, bringing the total case count for Allegheny County to 521. The latest cases include two females and two males in their teens, two females and a male in their 20s, a female in her 30s, two females in their 40s, two males and a female in their 50s, a male and female in their 60s, a female in her 70s and a female in her 80s. Only one of the latest cases has required hospitalization.

To date, 19,017 Allegheny County residents have been tested for COVID-19 and received their results. Of those, 18,496 were negative and 521 were positive. Currently, 39 Allegheny County residents are isolating with a COVID-19 diagnosis.
