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**ORDER OF TERMINATION OF PROBATION**

On or about October 20, 2016, the Maryland Board of Examiners for Audiologists, Hearing Aid Dispensers, and Speech-Language Pathologists (the “Board”) executed a “Consent Order of Probation,” which, among other things, placed Donnia Zack-Williams, license number 01403 (the “Petitioner”) on probation for a minimum of one (1) year, subject to certain probationary terms and conditions (Case No. AHS-37-2015). On or about June 5, 2018, the Petitioner petitioned the Board to terminate the probation upon her license. The Board considered the Petition and has decided to terminate the probation imposed by the October 20, 2016 Order based upon the Petitioner’s satisfactory compliance with the probationary terms set forth in that Order.

Wherefore, it is hereby:

**ORDERED** that the probation and all associated terms and conditions imposed Donnia Zack-Williams, license number 01403, as set forth in the “Consent Order of Probation” dated October 20, 2016 is hereby **LIFTED AND TERMINATED** and those terms and conditions have no further force and effect; and it is further

**ORDERED** that this is a Final Decision and Order of the Maryland Board of Examiners for Audiologists, Hearing Aid Dispensers, and Speech-Language Pathologists and as such is a **PUBLIC DOCUMENT** pursuant to Md. Code Ann., General Provisions §§ 4-101 *et seq.*
