ORDER LIFTING SUSPENSION OF
TRAINEE STATUS


On February 18, 2020, the Maryland State Board of Professional Counselors and Therapists (the “Board”) issued an Order of Suspension for Delinquent Child Support (“Order of Suspension”) against Richard E. Brooks, Jr. (the “Respondent”), ADT 1947. The Board suspended the Respondent’s trainee status due to delinquent child support payments upon request from the Department of Human Resources of Child Support Enforcement (the “Administration”), pursuant to Md. Code Ann., Fam. Law § 10-119.3(e)(2)(i)(2012 Repl. Vol.).

On or about April 20, 2020 the Board received a Notice to Reinstate Professional License from the Administration. Pursuant to the Maryland Practice Act, Md. Code Ann., Health Occ. § 17-101 *et seq.*, the Respondent otherwise qualifies for certification.

Therefore, pursuant to Md. Code Ann., Fam. Law §10-119.3(k), on this 21th day of April, by the Board, it is hereby:

ORDERED that the suspension of the Respondent’s trainee status in Maryland under ADT 1947 is hereby **LIFTED**; and it is further

ORDERED that this is a Final Order of the Board and, as such, is a public document pursuant to Md. Code Ann., State Gov’t, § 10-617(h).
