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ORDER OF MODIFICATION

The Maryland Board of Physical Therapy Examiners (the "Board") is in receipt of a request from Jessica Burns requesting modification of the terms of probation as set forth in a Pre-Charge Consent Order, dated October 2, 2008. The Pre-Charge Consent Order provides that Ms. Burns may petition for modification of the probationary terms after one (1) year of probation. Specifically, Ms. Burns requests lifting the probationary restriction prohibiting her from practicing in home health or nursing home settings, and the requirement that she practice under the supervision of an on-site physical therapist. Upon consideration of Ms. Burns' timely request, the Board voted to modify the terms of probation as ordered below.

ORDER

It is this 20th day of October, 2009, by an affirmative vote of the Maryland Board of Physical Therapy, hereby,

ORDERED that Ms. Burns may practice physical therapy in nursing home or home health settings; and be it further,

ORDERED that Ms. Burns may practice physical therapy without a licensed physical therapist on-site; and be it further,

ORDERED that all of the other terms of the October 2, 2008, Pre-Charge Consent Order remain in full force and effect; and be it further,

ORDERED that this is a formal order of the Maryland Board of Physical Therapy and as

such is a public document pursuant to the Maryland Annotated Code, State Government Article,
Section 10-617(h).
