- Friday April 3<sup>rd</sup>
  - Department of Budget and Management authorization to move forward with adjustment to Meaningful Day Retainer Payment
  - Maryland Department of Health's Medicaid Director submitted to the Center for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS)
  - CMS email acknowledgement of receipt



# The DDA Appendix K Update

#### • Monday April 6<sup>th</sup>

- CMS call to share overview of DDA's Appendix K
  - Retainer Payments receiving enhanced review and must be aligned with Maryland's Nursing Home bed hold days (i.e. 18 days)
  - CMS to share questions and concerns this week
  - CMS expediting review process and hope to have approval within 10 – 14 days



# The DDA Appendix K Update

#### **Next Steps**

- The DDA is reviewing program, fiscal, and operational changes needed
  - Guidance for stakeholders (*e.g.* who, what, when, how)
  - PCIS2 service authorization (*e.g.* retainer payments, increase services)
  - Medicaid Procedure Codes and tracking funding
  - "At A Glance" sheets to help inform stakeholder
- The DDA will continue to provide updates on the status



### **Personal Protective Equipment**

- The DDA received PPE supplies yesterday and the regional offices have started to distribute based on need
- The DDA is asking providers and people in self-direction to complete a PPE Needs Request Form to prioritized distribution based on need, utilization of other resources, and continued availability
- The priority is based on two (2) major areas:
  - 1. Outbreak staff or person in service tested COVID-19 positive
  - 2. No PPE supplies in the residence


