**CONSENT ORDER**

**PROCEDURAL BACKGROUND**

On April 20, 2016, the Maryland State Board of Dental Examiners (the "Board") charged VAQAR AHMAD CHOUDRY, D.D.S. (the "Respondent"), License Number 13215, with violating the Maryland Dentistry Act (the "Act"), Md. Code Ann., Health Occ. I ("Health Occ. I") §§ 4-101 *et seq.* (2014 Repl. Vol.) and Md. Code Regs. ("COMAR") 10.44.03 *et seq.* These charges amended and superseded the charges the Board issued against the Respondent, dated September 16, 2015. The Board held a hearing and issued an order on June 21, 2018. Dr. Choudry noted his appeal of the Board's order on July 19, 2018.

The parties have agreed to a modified sanction to fully and finally settle this matter. The sanction is set forth below.

**ORDER**

With the consent of the Respondent, it is now hereby:

**ORDERED** that the Respondent's license to practice dentistry in the State of Maryland be and is now hereby **REVOKED** for a period of **SIX (6) YEARS**, to commence on September 18, 2013; and it is further

**ORDERED** that the Respondent shall not apply to the Board to reinstate his license until after September 18, 2019; and it is further

**ORDERED** that the Board shall review the Respondent's application for reinstatement after September 19, 2019; and it is further

**ORDERED** that subject to Dr. Choudry meeting the minimum qualification for reinstatement, within a reasonable time following the Respondent's submission of his completed application, the Board shall issue a license subject to the following conditions of licensure:

1. Prior to issuance of the license, the Respondent will be cleared to practice by a Board-approved mental health provider;
2. The Respondent shall not treat minor patients;
3. The Respondent shall be placed on probation for 36 months;
4. During the probationary period, the Respondent's Board-approved mental health provider shall provide the Board quarterly reports on his fitness to practice and progress;
5. During the probationary period, the Respondent shall be prohibited from prescribing Schedule II and Schedule III medications; and
6. During the probationary period, the Respondent shall take and pass the Ethics and Boundaries examination; and it is further


**ORDERED** that the Respondent may request modification(s) of the foregoing conditions after twelve months; and it is further

**ORDERED** that upon the Respondent's submission of an application for a license, the grounds for discipline cited in the Board's Order dated June 21, 2018 shall not be considered by the Board when deciding whether the Respondent has the "good moral character" required by Health Occ. I § 4-302(b) to qualify for a license; and it is further

**ORDERED** that this Consent Order is considered a **PUBLIC DOCUMENT** pursuant to Md. Code Ann., General Provisions §§ 4-101 to 4-601.
