## **Subtitle 44 BOARD OF DENTAL EXAMINERS**

### **Chapter 20 Fees**

**Authority: Health Occupations Article, §§4-205, 4-207, and 4-304, Annotated Code of Maryland; Ch.469, Acts of 2006**

#### **.01 General.**

A. A person shall pay a fee as set forth in Regulation .02 of this chapter by check or money order.

B. The Board shall provide a copy of this chapter:

- (1) Along with any application form or renewal form; and
- (2) To any other person on request.

C. The Board shall refund the initial licensure or renewal fee, less a \$50 processing fee, to a dentist or a dental hygienist who does not qualify for initial licensure or renewal.

#### **.02 Fee Schedule.**

(4) Initial application fee for applicants holding an active license or certification to practice dental radiation technology in another state . . . \$20;

I. Reinstatement of lapsed license fee:

(1) Dentist . . . \$860;

(2) Dentist—teacher's license . . . \$225;

(4) Dental hygienist—teacher's license . . . \$225;

J. Lost, destroyed, or duplicate license fee . . . \$15;

K. Verification of licensure fee . . . \$20;

L. Specialty identification fee (one-time only) . . . \$150;

M. Advanced clinical training continuing education program application fee for a dentist who does not hold a Maryland license . . . \$25;

S. Certificate fee for a treating dentist to treat a patient at a practice location other than their own, at which anesthesia and sedation is administered to the patient:

- (1) Initial application . . . \$1000;
- (2) Renewal . . . \$300;
- (3) Additional location certificate . . . \$300;
- (4) Renewal of additional location certificate . . . \$300;

T. Dental hygienist recognition as qualified to administer local anesthesia . . . \$50;

U. Certificate fee for a treating dentist to allow a certified registered nurse anesthetist to administer anesthesia and sedation at a specific practice location:

- (1) Initial application . . . \$1000;
- (2) Renewal . . . \$300;
- (3) Additional location certificate . . . \$300;
- (4) Renewal of additional location certificate . . . \$300;

V. Dental hygienist recognition as qualified to monitor a patient to whom nitrous oxide has been administered . . . \$50;

W. Inactive status application fee (per renewal):

- (1) Dentist . . . \$150;
- (2) Dental hygienist . . . \$75;

X. Dispensing prescription drug permit fee . . . \$75;

Y. Application reprocessing fee . . . \$50;

Z. Corporate name application fee . . . \$150;

AA. Returned check fee . . . \$25;

BB. Late fee for failure to notify the Board within 60 days of change of address . . . \$10;

CC. Dentists—diskettes, labels, rosters, or tapes . . . \$190;

DD. Dental hygienists—diskettes, labels, rosters, or tapes . . . \$130;

EE. Dental assistants—diskettes, labels, rosters, or tapes . . . \$145;
