The regularly scheduled Open Session meeting of the Maryland State Board of Massage Therapy Examiners was held via teleconference call on January 27, 2021. The meeting was called to order at 10:04 a.m. by Board Chair Caitlin M. Thompson, LMT. Roll call was taken and all Board Members were present.

Review/Approval of the Open Session Minutes for December 23, 2020 - Kirsten Bodnarchuk motioned to accept the Amended Open Session Minutes; 2nd by Margaret Hayes. The motion passed. Board Vote: 7/0/0.

OLD BUSINESS - MATTERS FOR REPORTING

BOARD CHAIR REPORTS

Pearson Vue Update – The Executive Committee met Friday, January 21, 2021 with Ms. Oliver and Debra Persinger, Executive Director of FSMTB, to discuss options to administer the Jurisprudence Examination.

BOARD COUNSEL - Grant Gerber will report in the Legislative Session.

AMTA Updates – Amelia Mitchell – The Massage Therapy Bill writing is complete. However, there were a few edits such as deleting language to replace the term "Massage Parlor". The Bill cleans up language in the statute, adds Rap Back, COMTA endorsed curriculum for massage



training programs, and Inactive Status; removes insurance loop hole, and replaces Universal Precautions with Standard Precautions.

EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S REPORT

Sharon Oliver wished everyone a Happy New Year. She reported the Board continues to operate in accordance with Governor Hogan's Executive Order related to the extension of license renewals. Sharon Oliver reported on the following:

Introduction of Licensing Unit Manager - Christopher Hawkins, Sr. Christopher Hawkins, Sr. was introduced to and welcomed by the Board. He comes from the Barbers and Cosmetology Board, and has IT and licensing experience. Congratulations and welcome Christopher Hawkins, Sr. to the Board Staff!

COMMITTEE REPORTS

Licensing Committee (LRC) – Kirsten Bodnarchuk. LMT

RMP to LMT Conversion Recommendations - Kirsten Bodnarchuk presented four options for RMP to LMT conversion to the Board. The first two options require additional training beyond the 600 hours initial massage school education.

- (1) Use approved CE's to make up the additional 150 hours to satisfy the new 750 hours minimum in training.
- (2) 500 hours documented hands on experience and 120 CE credits
- (3) Legacy Status for all RMPs registered as of a certain date
- (4) 10 years + in practice automatically converts to LMT status.

The conversion process was referred back to the Advisory Committee for review and final recommendations. Board voted to table this decision.

Single Tier: Recommendation for LMT Requirements Moving Forward - The LRC made the following recommendations to qualify for LMT status:



- (1) New educational requirements of a 750 Hour Massage Education
- (2) Addition of research as a requirement in the educational program
- (3) CPR certification at the Basic Life Support level
- (4) Removal of College credits as a requirement.

The Board accepted all of the recommendations presented by the LRC Committee.

Advanced Massage Course Review – A draft list of advanced massage therapy courses has been requested. Kirsten Bodnarchuk will email the draft list of courses for Board Member review and feedback.

Advisory Committee – Paula Jilanis, LMT

The Advisory Committee met on Thursday, January 14, 2021 to discuss COMTA endorsed Curriculum, pass rates for schools, and reviewed regulations from other States. Many questions exist. The Advisory Committee is still gathering information. Updates to follow.
