Dr. Stephanie Chaney called the meeting to order at 2:30 P.M. (NOTE: The General Session followed the Disciplinary Hearing scheduled for 10:00 A.M. Refer to the Executive Session for details.)

Review of Agenda and Minutes

The October 14th Agenda was amended as follows: 1) under no. 5n., amend trade name to "Trinity Therapeutic Massage & Bodywork – Ceili E. Betsch, LMT"; 2) add no. 8, "Petition from Mr. Michael Brown, LMT"; and 3) add no. 9, "Petition from Ms. Lucia Crowder, LMT." Ms. Hucek made a motion to accept the amended Agenda; Dr. Sadula seconded, and the motion was unanimously voted.

The September 9th Minutes were approved as drafted. Dr. Sadula motioned to accept the Minutes; Ms. Hucek seconded, and the motion was unanimously voted.

Review of Administrative Staff Issues, Mr. J.J. Vallone, Executive Director

Ms. Danielle Gonnelli has been re-assigned to work as a contractual Investigator for the Dental Board. Ms. Gonnelli's salary will be paid by the Chiropractic Board; the Dental Board is working on assigning her on as a full-time employee with benefits.

- ➤ Update: 2010-2012 Massage Therapy Biennial Renewal: Ms. Congo discussed the progress of the on-line massage renewal. Currently, 1,099 LMTs (3,012 total records) have completed their on-line renewals, and 260 RMPs (887 total records) have completed their on-line renewals. The next couple of weeks should be challenging as licensees/registrants renew before the 10/31/2010 deadline; a mandatory \$200 late fee will be imposed on 11/01/2010. The staff is working very hard in processing renewals and printing/mailing licenses/registrations.
- ➤ Update: Regulation Revision Status/Progress: The Regulations have been signed-off by the Board Counsel; it is currently at the AELR (Joint Standing Committee on Administrative Executive and Legislative Review). The Board hopes to get the Regulations adopted before the legislative session begins. The Board acknowledged the hard work and many hours Ms. Congo devoted to processing the Regulations.
- > Out-of-State Travel for Board Members/Staff: Funds for out-of-state travel was in a complete freeze. The freeze is somewhat lifted for those individuals who will be traveling out-of-state and voting at conferences; also, investigators who need certifications will be allowed to travel.

The following trade name "Heavenly Touch – Susan E. England, LMT" was denied by Board motion. Dr. Chaney supported the motion, Dr. Fedorczyk seconded and the motion was unanimously voted.

Request for Trade Name Change - Michael A. Dorn, Jr., D.C.

Dr. Dorn requests Board approval to change his trade name to "Baltimore Back and Pain Center, Michael A. Dorn, Jr., D.C." (formerly: Hampden Family Chiropractic, LLC; not previously Board-approved). Ms. Hucek made a motion to approve the trade name change; Dr. Nou seconded, and the motion was unanimously voted.

Petition from Marty V. Cairns, D.C.

Dr. Cairns petitions the Board to consider expansion of the Maryland Chiropractic Scope of Practice to include the restricted use of "nature-based prescription non-narcotic pharmaceutical medication" that would be limited for the purpose of diagnosing the primary disorder(s) of the musculo-skeletal system, provided that licensees are sufficiently educated and trained to safely engage in the procedure. Dr. Cairns states that the nature-based prescription non-narcotic pharmaceutical medication can be delivered via oral ingestion, transcutaneously, or injection that does not require the use of guided imaging. The Board entered into a full discussion and concluded that, other than intravenous application of nature-based substances, the current Maryland law suffices to permit the full use of non-legend, holistic/nature-based substances within the scope of chiropractic testing and treatment.

Petition from Ms. Teresa M. Rudolph, Massage Therapy Applicant

Ms. Rudolph, who is licensed in Delaware, Virginia, and Washington, D.C., petitions the Board for State licensure by waiver because she did not graduate from a Board-approved massage school. Ms. Rudolph and other visitors exited the Board Meeting as the Board Counsel entered into a "closed session" to discuss the petition. Ms. Rudolph was asked to return to the meeting for the Board's decision. The Board determined that, pursuant to the waiver provisions of the Board Regulations, Ms. Rudolph's educational background, massage therapy credentials, and experience meet the requirements for application to the Board. The Board motioned to accept Ms. Rudolph's application for licensure as an LMT, contingent on successfully completing the Maryland jurisprudence examination scheduled for November 22nd. Mr. Anderson supported the motion; Ms. Jolivet seconded, and the motion was unanimously voted.

Petition from Mr. Michael Brown, LMT

Mr. Brown petitions the Board regarding the following: 1) can LMTs use and recommend hydrotherapy, and 2) can LMTs perform breast massage on females, with or without a doctor's prescription? The Board discussed and motioned that yes, hydrotherapy packs (both heat and cold) can be used by LMTs. The Board also discussed and motioned that if it's medically indicated, breast massage (cancer, mastectomy, etc.) can be performed by an LMT who has didactic and clinical training at a bona fide school or course of instruction; an LMT should also receive a written Informed Consent Form from the patient. Mr. Anderson supported the motion; Dr. Sadula seconded, and the motion was unanimously voted.

Petition from Lucia Crowder, LMT

Ms. Crowder petitions the Board to utilize her training in YogaFit to meet the massage therapy CEU renewal requirements. (NOTE: The course was not pre-approved by the Board.) The Board motioned to give 6 CEU credits for the training; Ms. Crowder would need 12 more CEUs in massage-related courses and also complete a minimum of 3 CEUs in ethics or jurisprudence, and 3 CEUs of Communicable Diseases education which includes AIDS/HIV. Mr. Anderson supported the motion; Dr. Sadula seconded, and the motion was unanimously voted.

Upon motion by Dr. Chaney, seconded by Dr. Sadula, the Board unanimously voted to adjourn the General Session at 3:20 P.M.
