ORDER LIFTING SUSPENSION OF REGISTRATION
TO PRACTICE MASSAGE THERAPY


On March 1, 2014 the Maryland Board of Chiropractic and Massage Therapy Examiners (the "Board") issued an Order of Registration Suspension for Delinquent Child Support ("Order of Suspension") against Dwayne Haynes, RMP, Registration No. R01896 (the "Respondent"). The Board suspended the Respondent's registration to practice as a registered massage practitioner due to his delinquent child support payments upon a request for the Prince George's County Office of Child Support Enforcement of the Maryland Department of Human Resources (the "Administration"), pursuant to Md. Code Ann., Fam. Law, § 10-119.3e(2)(i)(2012 Repl. Vol.).

On or about September 16, 2014 the Board received a Notice to Reinstate the Respondent's registration from the Administration. Pursuant to the Maryland Chiropractic Act, Maryland Code Ann., Health Occ., §§ 3-101 et seq. (2012 Repl. Vol.), the Respondent otherwise qualifies for a registration.

Therefore, pursuant to Md. Code Ann., Fam. Law, § 10-119.3(k), on this ____ day of September, 2014, by the Maryland Board of Chiropractic and Massage Therapy Examiners, it is hereby:

ORDERED that the suspension of the registration to practice as a registered massage practitioner in Maryland held by Dwayne Haynes, Registration No. R01896, is **LIFTED**; and it is further

ORDERED that this is a Final Order of the Maryland Board of Chiropractic and Massage Therapy Examiners and, as such, is a public document pursuant to Md. Code Ann., State Gov't, §§ 10-617(h).
