**ORDER LIFTING SUSPENSION OF LICENSE TO PRACTICE MASSAGE THERAPY**


On February 6, 2017, the Maryland Board of Massage Therapy Examiners (the "Board") issued an Order of Suspension of Registration for Delinquent Child Support ("Order of Suspension") against LeRoy Mack, Jr., Reg. No. R02005 (the "Respondent"). The Board suspended the Respondent's registration to practice due to his delinquent child support payments upon request of the Baltimore County Office of Child Support Enforcement of the Maryland Department of Human Resources (the "Administration"), pursuant to Md. Code Ann., Fam. Law, § 10-119.3e(2)(i)(2012 Repl. Vol.).

On or about April 17, 2017, the Board received a Notice to Reinstate the Respondent's registration from the Administration. Pursuant to the Maryland Massage Therapy Act, Maryland Code Ann., Health Occ., §§ 6-101 et seq. (2012 Repl. Vol.), the Respondent otherwise qualifies for a registration.

Therefore, pursuant to Md. Code Ann., Fam. Law, § 10-119.3(k), on this 17th day of April, 2017, by the Maryland Board of Massage Therapy Examiners, it is hereby:

**ORDERED** that the suspension of the registration to practice as a massage practitioner in Maryland held by LeRoy Mack, Jr., is **LIFTED**; and it is further

**ORDERED** that this is a Final Order of the Maryland Board of Massage Therapy Examiners and, as such, is a public document pursuant to Md. Code Ann., Gen. Prov., §4-333.
