ORDER LIFTING SUSPENSION OF LICENSE
TO PRACTICE MASSAGE THERAPY

On May 3, 2016, the Maryland Board of Chiropractic & Massage Therapy Examiners (the "Board") issued an Order of Suspension of License for Delinquent Child Support against Reynold Roberts, RMP (the "Respondent"). The Board suspended the Respondent's license to practice due to his delinquent child support payments upon request of the Baltimore City Office of Child Support Enforcement of the Maryland Department of Human Resources (the "Administration"), pursuant to Md. Code Ann., Fam. Law, § 10-119.3e(2)(i)(2012 Repl. Vol.).

On or about May 20, 2016, the Board received a Notice to Reinstate the Respondent's license from the Administration. Pursuant to the Maryland Chiropractic Act, Md. Code Ann., Health Occ., §§ 3-101 et seq. (2012 Repl. Vol.), the Respondent otherwise qualifies for a license.

Therefore, pursuant to Md. Code Ann., Fam. Law, § 10-119.3(k), on this 23th day of May, 2016, by the Maryland Board of Chiropractic & Massage Therapy Examiners, it is hereby:

ORDERED that the suspension of the license to practice as a registered massage practioner in Maryland held by Reynold Roberts, is **LIFTED**; and it is further

ORDERED that this is a Final Order of the Maryland Board of Chiropractic & Massage Therapy Examiners and, as such, is a public document pursuant to Md. Code Ann., Gen. Prov., §4-333.
