SUMMARY:

This action transmittal provides policy about a recent amendment to the federal National Flood Insurance Act of 1968. The Act was amended to state that payments made under the National Flood Insurance Program (NFIP) are not counted as income or resources of the owner of the property when determining eligibility for any federal means-tested program.

The Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) awards grants to States and communities. The State or community then gives the payments to individuals and businesses for activities that reduce the risk of repetitive flood damage.

NEW POLICY:

Do not count any payments received by property owners under NFIP as a resource or as income.

CARES Procedures:

- Enter a Source code of "ON" (Other Non-Countable All Programs) on the UINC screen.
- □ Enter the NFIP amount, verification code and frequency code.
