**SUBJECT:** Medical Eligibility Review Process – Reimbursement Level

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Effective immediately, KePRO, the Medical Assistance Program's Utilization Control Agent, will no longer be required to assign a reimbursement level (i.e., light, moderate, or heavy) to medical eligibility requests for the following Waivers: Medical Day Care, Older Adults, or Living at Home services. The elimination of this step will facilitate a more timely response to medical eligibility requests.
