Re: July 1, 2011 Provider Fee Schedule Change

In compliance with the FY 2012 budget passed by the Maryland General Assembly, the
fee schedule for the following types of providers will be reduced by an average of 1
percent beginning July 1, 2011: Physicians, Osteopaths, Physical Therapists,
Occupational Therapists, Speech Therapists, Nurse Practitioners, Nurse Anesthetists,
Certified Nurse Midwives, Podiatrists, Optometrists, Nutritionists, Audiologists, and
Therapeutic Behavioral Aides.
