RE: New Vendor for Assisted Living Manager Course

Date: February 13, 2008

The Office of Health Care Quality (OHCQ) is pleased to announce the addition of a new vendor approved to provide the 80-hour assisted living manager (ALM) training, as outlined in COMAR 10.07.14.15-1 and .15-2 (See attached chart). In addition, all of the vendors approved to provide the 80-hour ALM training course are also approved to provide the 20 hours of continuing education that must be completed every two years by **ALL** assisted living managers employed in an assisted living program licensed for 5 beds or more. As ALM training curriculums are approved, updates will be made available on the OHCQ website <a href="https://www.dhmh.state.md.us/ohcq">www.dhmh.state.md.us/ohcq</a> located under the training heading.

Please note that the regulations require that all managers employed in an assisted living program licensed for 5 beds or more complete an approved manager training course. However, due to the lack of training courses in the past, OHCQ has not enforced this requirement. Considering there are currently only four approved courses, at this time assisted living managers have until August 2008 to comply with this training requirement. Pending the availability of approved ALM training courses, the proposed target date for compliance may be reconsidered. Nevertheless, assisted living managers are encouraged to take an approved training course in advance of OHCQ's enforcement of the training requirement, as we believe this training will benefit resident care.

Additionally, an individual will be exempt from the 80-hour ALM course if employed as an assisted living manager in Maryland for one year before January 1, 2006 (COMAR 10.07.14.15-1 E(3)). However, due to the limited number of approved vendors to teach the 80 hour assisted living manager training course, the OHCQ will, in practice, exempt an individual who has been employed as an assisted living manager in Maryland for one year before January 1, 2008. Until then, during our survey inspections, OHCQ will determine if an ALM is sufficiently qualified to serve as an assisted living manager by referring to COMAR 10.07.14.15B. This standard will hold true for assisted living managers who are exempt as well as those who are required to take the 80-hour ALM course.

Please note that being exempt from taking the 80-hour ALM training course does not exempt an ALM from completing the required 20 hours of continuing education every two years.
