

COVID – 19 UPDATE

The Maryland Board of Examiners in Optometry echoes the recommendations as set forth by the Maryland Department of Health (MDH).

Per their website, the Maryland Department of Health recommends:

“MDH reiterates the importance of its guidance for facilities that serve older adults:

- Restrict access to essential visits only.
- Restrict activities and visitors with potential for exposure.
- Actively screen individuals entering the building and restrict entry to those with respiratory symptoms or possible exposure to COVID-19.
- Require all individuals entering the building to wash their hands at entry.
- Establish processes to allow remote communication for residents and others.
- Prohibit all staff from international travel.”
