**ORDER OF MODIFICATION**

The Maryland Board of Pharmacy is in receipt of a petition from James Cianos, License No. 09089, requesting modification of the terms of probation as set forth in the Consent Order of Reinstatement, dated September 19, 2007. The Consent Order provides that Mr. Cianos may petition for modification of the probationary terms after one (1) year of probation. Specifically, Mr. Cianos requests lifting the limitation on his practice as a dispensing pharmacist and the prohibition against access to controlled dangerous substances. Upon consideration of Mr. Cianos's request, the Board voted to modify the terms of probation as ordered below.

**ORDER**

It is this 3 day of FEBRUARY 2009, by an affirmative vote of the Maryland Board of Pharmacy, hereby,

**ORDERED** that Mr. Cianos may practice pharmacy as a dispensing pharmacist; and be it further,


**ORDERED** that Mr. Cianos may have access to controlled dangerous substances; and be it further,

**ORDERED** that Mr. Cianos shall be subject to random urine screens every other week as directed by the Board; and be it further

**ORDERED** that all of the other terms of the September 19, 2007, Consent Order remain in full force and effect; and be it further,

**ORDERED** that this is a formal order of the Maryland Board of Pharmacy and as such is a public document pursuant to the Maryland Annotated Code, State Government Article, Section 10-617(h).
