ORDER TERMINATING PROBATION AND
REINSTATING PHARMACY LICENSE

By Order dated August 3, 1983 (the "1983 Order"), the Maryland Board of Pharmacy (the "Board") found Gary A. Lesser, P.D. (the "Respondent") guilty of violating §12-311(b) (7) and (14) of the Health Occupations Article. The Board reprimanded the Respondent and placed him on probation subject to certain conditions (the "Conditions of Probation").

By letter received July 30, 1985, Respondent petitioned the Board for reinstatement of his license to practice pharmacy in Maryland without any condition or restriction. At its meeting on August 21, 1985, the Board reviewed Respondent's petition for reinstatement. Based on its review of that petition and the reports submitted to the Board by the persons monitoring Respondent's progress pursuant to the Conditions of Probation, the Board determined that respondent had satisfactorily fulfilled all of the Condition of Probation contained in the 1983 Order.

FINDING OF FACT

The Board finds that Respondent has satisfactorily complied with all the Conditions of Probation imposed by its 1983 Order.

CONCLUSION OF LAW


The Board concludes as a matter of law that it is appropriate to terminate Respondent's Conditions of Probation and to reinstate his pharmacy license without any condition or restriction.


