ORDER TERMINATING PROBATION AND
REINSTATING PHARMACIST LICENSE

By Order dated April 20, 1983, ("the 1983 Order"), the Maryland Board of Pharmacy (the "Board") found Philip Morawski, P.D. (the "Respondent") guilty of violating Section 12-313(b)(7),(14), and (20) of the Health Occupations Article. The Board ordered that Respondent's license to practice pharmacy in the State of Maryland be **SUSPENDED**. The suspension was stayed and Respondent was placed on probation subject to certain conditions (the "Conditions of Probation").

At its meeting of September 15, 1993, the Board considered the Respondent's petition of August 24, 1993 for reinstatement of his license to practice pharmacy in Maryland without conditions or restrictions. Based upon his petition and information received at the August 24, 1993 meeting, the Board determined that the Respondent could apply for reinstatement after complying with several conditions. At its meeting of July 20, 1994, the Board reviewed Respondent's compliance with the conditions specified on August 24, 1994. Based on its review, the Board determined that Respondent had satisfactorily fulfilled all of the Conditions contained in the 1983 Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

The Board finds that Respondent has satisfactorily complied with all the Conditions imposed by its 1983 Order.

CONCLUSION OF LAW


The Board concludes as a matter of law that it is appropriate to terminate Respondent's Conditions on his license and to reinstate his pharmacist license without any condition or restriction.

ORDER

UPON THE FOREGOING Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, it is this 20th day of July, 1994 by unanimous vote of a quorum of the Board

ORDERED that effective as of the date of this Order, the Conditions imposed on Respondent's practice of pharmacy by the Board's 1983 Order are hereby **TERMINATED** and of no force and effect; and be it further

ORDERED that Respondent's license to practice pharmacy in the State of Maryland be **REINSTATED** without any condition or restriction whatsoever.
