 - **Breast and Cervical Cancer Program (BCCP) Inquiries** BCCP is currently working on the CDC funding application and some programs may notice a delay in responses to their inquiries from BCCP staff.
 - Limited English Proficiency (LEP) Requirements Updates to LEP requirements have been recently released to incorporate Section 1557 of the Affordable Care Act (ACA), the non-discrimination provision of the ACA, which prohibits discrimination on the basis of race, color, national origin, sex, age, or disability in certain health programs or activities. As part of your program's implementation of the LEP, we ask programs to do the following:
 - Review all LEP requirements and resources with program staff.
 - Ensure all current procedures related to providing or mailing significant information to the public incorporates the new LEP requirements. This includes:
 - Mailings to the public that contain significant information or require a response or action (i.e. completion of forms, letters that require follow-up).
 - Notification of deadlines and adverse action if action is not taken.
 - Advising the public of rights or eligibility criteria.
 - Post or provide information the following as appropriate (*See Attachment 1, LEP Documents*):
 - Notice to the Public: Non-Discrimination Policy Statement and Complaint Procedure
 - Notice to the Public: Non-Discrimination Statement and Accessibility Requirement with the top 15 languages spoken
 - DHMH Non-Discriminatory Statement and Taglines for Small Sized Significant Publications and Communications
 - o Language Line Solutions Language Identification poster

- Colorectal Cancer Awareness Proclamation Due torequests for the proclamation to include more current data, the Governor Proclamation will be released later in the month of March date TBA. A local proclamation will be released with the colorectal cancer toolkit by the first week of March for programs to utilize.

 - This needs assessment will serve as a tool for the CRFP Unit to evaluate training needs and identify areas of process improvement for our funded programs.

 - Integrated BCCP/CPEST clinical standards for select clinical procedures
 - Integrated BCCP/CPEST intake form
- **Medical Advisory Committee** The CRFP Unit will be convening both Lung Cancer and Colorectal Cancer Medical Advisory Committees in the coming months to discuss the development of lung cancer clinical guidance and updates to the current colorectal cancer clinical guidance.
