What is the Maryland Cancer Fund?

- The Maryland Cancer Fund provides funding and resources for cancer prevention, screening, and treatment programs in Maryland.
- The Maryland Cancer Fund is completely funded through direct contributions.

What has the Maryland Cancer Fund accomplished?

- Cancer screenings provided for more than 650 people.
- Cancer diagnosis and treatment services provided for more than 175 people.

Why should you donate to the Maryland Cancer Fund?

- Cancer is the second leading cause of death in Maryland.
- In 2014 alone, nearly 30,680 Marylanders will be diagnosed with cancer and more than 10,500 will die from cancer.

How can you donate to the Maryland Cancer Fund?

- Indicate a contribution on Line 37 of the **Maryland Income Tax Return**. Donate any amount. The donation will either reduce a refund or increase the tax payment. All donations are tax deductible.
