RE: Federal Poverty Guidelines, 2015 by Annual Household Income and Family Size

Attached is a table of the Federal HHS Poverty Guidelines (FPG) for calendar year 2015, which took effect on January 22, 2015. The definition of low income for the Cigarette Restitution Fund (CRF) Programs is less than or equal to 250% of the Federal Poverty Guidelines. Provided in the table is the FPG at 250% as determined by size of a family.

Persons in Family	250% of Federal Poverty Guideline for eligibility to CRF Programs
1	\$29,425
2	\$39,825
3	\$50,225
4	\$60,625
5	\$71,025
6	\$81,425
7	\$91,825
8	\$102,225
For families with more than 8 persons, add \$10,400 for each additional person.
