WHEN USING MARYLAND BRFSS DATA, PLEASE NOTE THE FOLLOWING:

N = Estimated number of Maryland adults with the condition or behavior of interest

% = Prevalence of condition or behavior of interest in the non-institutionalized adult population of Maryland, age 18 and above

LL = Lower limit of 95% confidence interval for the prevalence estimate

UL = Upper limit of 95% confidence interval for the prevalence estimate

* = Data suppressed

As per Centers for Disease Control and Prevention protocol for the BRFSS survey, data must be suppressed when either of two conditions are met:

1 - Total n < 50

2 - The coefficient of variation for the estimate is $\geq 30.0\%$

BMI = Body Mass Index

Data and format provided is designed to be consistent with what is available on the Maryland BRFSS website for prior survey years.

Data for Cancer Survivors and Cancer Survivorship are not reportable at county levels, and so are excluded from this report.

Fruit and Vegetable data are not typically reported by use of the exact questions but by a summary variable that incorporates the full module. Data for summary variables are presented.

Cancer screening data such as sigmoidoscopy and colonoscopy, blood stool tests, mammograms, and pap smears were not collected in the 2015 Maryland BRFSS.

Childhood asthma data was not collected in the 2015 Maryland BRFSS.

Seatbelt use categories were combined to facilitate analysis at the county level in accordance with the most recent progress update towards HP2020 objectives.
