INTRODUCTION AND BACKGROUND

Maryland's 24 Local Health Departments (LHDs) continue to assess their capabilities, readiness and challenges to bill insurance providers and collect for healthcare services. Each LHD is at a different stage of formalized payer contracts and commercial and managed care billing. LHD capability in billing for healthcare services is based on clinical operations, front-end billing processes, coding, backend billing processes, information technology infrastructure, credentialing and contracting.

In an effort to assist the LHDs in building a strong, effective and compliant billing infrastructure, DHMH retained the firm of Rosen, Sapperstein & Friedlander, LLC (RS&F), formerly SHR Associates, Inc., to create this Maryland LHD Billing Manual.
