Regulatory Review

SB 82/HB 233 – State Board of Examiners for Audiologists, Hearing Aid Dispensers & Speech-Language Pathologists- Maryland Music Therapists Act.

Stakeholders were invited to speak in open session to express their opinions and concerns regarding the Boards support to the Maryland Music Therapists Act. Speakers were granted 3 minutes to voice their concerns. The Bill has passed in both the House and the Senate and has crossed over to the opposite chamber. MSHA and ASHA have sent letters of concerns to

legislators to prevent the bill from passing into law. Ms. Cole also suggested establishing a working group to determine the regulations for Music Therapists in the event the bill does in fact become law. The working group would also include stakeholders. Board members were able to hear from each speaker and voted on the following:

Ms. Stine made a motion to amend the bill to remove lines 5-8 on page 10. Dr. Kearney seconded the motion. The vote was unanimous.

Dr. Kearney made a motion to amend the bill to revise the language on page 9 lines 7-9 to state that Music Therapists will treat an individual with a communication disorder and not a communication disorder. Ms. Stine seconded the motion. Ms. Silverman abstained. The vote was unanimous.

Ms. Silverman made a motion to rescind the Board's support of the bill as written and to find a sponsor to bring the proposed amendments to the floor. The vote was unanimous.
