OPEN SESSION MINUTES

January 28, 2020

1. <u>CALL TO ORDER/GREETINGS</u>: Board President, Dr. Mark Bailey called the meeting to order at 7:05 p.m. and welcomed everyone to the open session to discuss Legislative Action concerning HB106/SB439 – Health Occupations – Morticians and Funeral Directors - Apprenticeships

2. PRESIDENT'S REMARKS: Dr. Bailey summarized the details of the changes addressed in HB106/SB439. This bill would require an applicant for an apprentice license issued by the Maryland Board of Morticians and Funeral Directors to be enrolled in or have graduated from a mortuary science program, to stay enrolled in the program during the apprenticeship, and to complete at least 1,000 working hours in a licensed funeral establishment under the direct supervision of the apprentice sponsor.

3. <u>LEGISLATIVE ACTION</u>:

- I. Legislative Committee Chair Sheria Jennings made a motion to have the Board approve taking a position of support for HB106. The motion was seconded by Dr. Ahmed Elzaree, and the Board unanimously approved supporting HB106.
- II. Chair Sheria Jennings made a motion to have the Board approve taking a position of support for SB439, the cross-file for HB106. The motion was seconded by Melanie Oppat and the Board unanimously approved supporting SB439.
