Dear Mr. Borro:

On February 2, 2018, pursuant to Md. Code Ann., State Gov't § 10-226(c)(2), the Maryland State Board of Examiners of Nursing Home Administrators (the "Board") issued an **ORDER FOR SUMMARY SUSPENSION OF LICENSE TO PRACTICE AS A NURSING HOME ADMINISTRATOR** regarding your license. Also, on February 2, 2018, you were hand-delivered the order and the letter of procedure, which stated that the post-deprivation hearing was scheduled for 1:00 p.m., on February 14, 2018, at 4201 Patterson Avenue, Room 106, Baltimore, Maryland 21215. On February 14, 2018, the Board held the post-deprivation hearing, giving you an opportunity to argue why the summary suspension should not continue. You did not attend the hearing, and no attorney appeared on your behalf. The State was represented by Robert J. Gilbert and Kelly Cooper, Assistant Attorneys General, Administrative Prosecutors, representing the State.

After consideration of the presentation by the State, the Board found that the public health, safety or welfare imperatively requires the summary suspension of your license. *See* State Gov't § 10-226(c)(2)(i); COMAR 10.33.01.20E(2) The Board, therefore, affirmed the order of summary suspension. *See* COMAR 10.33.01.20F(2)(a).


NOTICE OF RIGHT TO APPEAL
