**ORDER OF TERMINATION OF PROBATION AND  
REINSTATEMENT WITHOUT CONDITIONS**

**PROCEDURAL BACKGROUND**

On March 21, 2007 the Maryland State Board of Dental Examiners (the "Board") and Qinghong Shi, D.D.S. ("Respondent") entered into a Final Consent Order (the "Order") which is incorporated by reference as if fully set forth herein.

The pertinent terms and conditions of the Order were that the Respondent was to serve a two (2) year period of probation; and would be subject to unannounced Centers for Disease Control ("CDC") inspections by a Board approved CDC consultant. After one (1) year had elapsed, the Respondent would be able to petition the Board for termination of probation without restrictions.

**FINDINGS OF FACT**

1. On March 21, 2007, the Respondent entered into a Final Consent Order with the Board.
2. The Respondent has completed twelve (12) months of probation and has satisfactorily complied with all of the conditions of the Order.

3. The Respondent has petitioned the Board to terminate probation and to reinstate his license to practice dentistry without any conditions whatsoever.

4. On May 21, 2008, a full quorum of the Board voted to grant Respondent's petition.

**CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

Based on the foregoing Findings of Fact, the Maryland State Board of Dental Examiners concludes, as a matter of law, that the Respondent has met the conditions attached to his probation.

**ORDER**



**ORDERED** that the Respondent's probation be and is terminated; and it is further

**ORDERED** that Respondent's Maryland dental license be and is reinstated without conditions; and it is further

**ORDERED** that this Order for Termination of Probation and Reinstatement Without Conditions is a public document pursuant to Md. Code Ann., State Gov't Article, § 10-611 *et seq.*
