Our goal is simple; to offer exceptional customer service to the state's licensees and citizens. The unit processes initial license and renewal applications, and responds to inquiries from potential licensees who are considering practicing in Maryland.

THE LICENSING UNIT TEAM

Deborah A. Welch Licensing Unit Coordinator

Ms. Welch is responsible for training, coordinating, and managing the unit. There are approximately 25,000 dentists, dental hygienists, and dental radiation technologists in Maryland whose licenses or certificates must be renewed every two years. Ms. Welch insures that applications are handled in an expeditious manner so that our licensees do not experience unnecessary delays in receiving their license. Additionally, Ms. Welch and her unit provide administrative support for the Board's Applications Committee.

Sandra Sage **Dental Hygienist** Licensing Coordinator

Ms. Sage's primary task is licensure of dental hygienists as well as the issuance of local anesthesia and nitrous oxide certificates for hygienists. She also processes applications for dental organizations seeking to obtain temporary dental clinic permits which allow out of State licensees to participate in pro bono programs in Maryland. Ms. Sage is also one of the Board's computer specialists.

Debbie M. Wurster Dental Assistant Coordinator

Ms. Wurster is responsible for all tasks related to dental assistants, including dental radiation technologists, dental assistants qualified in general duties, and dental assistants gualified in orthodontics. Ms. Wurster also handles the Board's continuing education audits as well as applications for continuing education course approval.

Summary of Recent Developments in the Law Regarding the Administration of Nitrous Oxide Ali Behnia, DMD

During the 2016 legislative session the Maryland General Assembly passed House Bill 470, chapter 106, which permits licensed dental hygienists to administer nitrous oxide to dental patients under certain prescribed circumstances. The following is a summary of the law and the recently

enacted regulations.

It is not intended to be exhaustive. Please refer to the actual law and the regulations.

- Under House Bill 470 a dental hygienist must complete the educational requirements established by the Board through an accredited dental hygiene program.
- A dental hygienist who is recognized by the Board to administer nitrous oxide will be able to do so only under the supervision of a dentist who is physically on the premises and who prescribes the administration of nitrous oxide by the dental hygienist.
- The dental hygienist may not leave the operatory during the administration or monitoring of the nitrous oxide except in emergency circumstances.
- To be recognized by the Board to administer nitrous oxide to a dental patient a Maryland licensed dental hygienist must:
- Complete a six-hour Board-approve course of instruction on the administration of nitrous oxide through an accredited dental hygiene program; and
- Submit proof of having passed the Commission on Dental Competency Assessments (or its successor organization) Nitrous Oxide Examination for Dental Hygienists; and
- Submit a Board-approved application along with a one-time \$50 application fee. The recognition will not expire.
- A dental hygienist licensed in Maryland who is licensed or certified in another state to administer nitrous oxide may administer nitrous oxide in Maryland without completing the 6-hour Board-approved course under certain prescribed circumstances. Those affected should call the Board for additional information.
- Those who hold Board recognition to monitor nitrous oxide may continue to monitor the administration of nitrous oxide by a dentist but they may not administer nitrous oxide until they meet the Board's requirements and receive Board recognition to administer nitrous oxide.

However, a patient is entitled to a copy of their records, or the patient may request that the copies be forwarded to another health care provider.

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THE DENTAL **BOARD'S MISSION**

The Dental Board is a regulatory body whose sole mission is to protect the public and promote quality health care in the field of dentistry.

The Board of Dental Examiners protects the citizens of Maryland by:

1. Licensing and regulating the practice of dentistry, dental hygiene, and dental radiation technology.

The Board fulfills this mandate by reviewing every initial application that is sent to the Board. All candidates for licensure must have the necessary educational credentials and work related experience.

2. Resolving complaints against licensees who may have violated the Dental Practice Act and its regulations.

The Board receives approximately 300 complaints each year. The Board investigates each complaint that alleges facts which if true, would constitute a violation of the dental laws. Outcomes of board actions include closing the complaint, writing a letter of education or an advisory letter wherein the licensee is informed of shortcomings in their practice, to formal charges after the opportunity for a hearing, and revocation of a license if warranted.

3. Setting standards for the practice of dentistry, dental hygiene and dental radiation technology that reflect new and emergent developments in the profession through legislation and regulation.
