ORDER FOR TERMINATION OF PROBATION

ORDER FOR REINSTATEMENT WITHOUT CONDITIONS

PROCEDURAL BACKGROUND

On January 19, 2005 the Maryland State Board of Dental Examiners (the "Board") and Payam Hariri, D.M.D. ("Respondent") entered into a Consent Order (the "Order") which is incorporated by reference as if fully set forth herein.

The pertinent terms and conditions of the Order were that the Respondent received a **REPRIMAND**, was placed on **PROBATION** for a period of three (3) years and was ordered to: pay a fine in the amount of \$1,000.00.00 within six (6) months of the Order; and to successfully complete, within one hundred and twenty days of he Order, the JERM and DSCE examinations. After one year of probation elapsed, the Respondent could petition for termination of the probation with out conditions provided he successfully complied with all conditions of the Order.

The Respondent, having complied with the aforementioned conditions meets the requirement for reinstatement without conditions.

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. On January 19, 2005, the Respondent entered into a Consent Order with the Board.
 - 2. The Respondent has successfully complied with the terms of the Order.
- 3. On February 1, 2006, a full quorum of the Board voted to terminate probation and to reinstate the Respondent without conditions.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Based on the foregoing Findings of Fact, the Maryland State Boards of Dental Examiners concludes, as a matter of law, that the Respondent meets the requirements for termination of probation and reinstatement of his Maryland Dental license without conditions.

ORDER

Based on the foregoing Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, it is, this 13 day of March, 2006, by the Maryland State Board of Dental Examiners hereby:

ORDERED that, the Maryland dental license of the Respondent, Payam Hariri, D.M.D. be **REINSTATED** without any conditions what so ever.

ORDERED that this Order for Reinstatement is a public document pursuant to Md. Code Ann., State Gov't Article, § 10-611 et seq.
