Message from the EDITOR

I have been a member of the Maryland State Board of Dental Examiners for more than four years. It has been a great learning experience, as well as a fulfilling one. I am thankful to my fellow Board members and staff who are dedicated to fulfilling the mission of the Board, to serve and protect the citizens and practitioners of our State.


Your Dental Board meets two Wednesdays each month, both as a full Board and in various committees. On the first Wednesday of the month the full Board meets in open session. Our licensees and the general public are invited to attend the open session meetings which typically last from one to two hours. The Board also meets in closed executive session on the third Wednesday of the month at which time the Board reviews complaints against our licensees. By law those meetings are not open to the public.

The Board recently launched, what has become, a very popular Centers for Disease Control pilot program designed entirely to benefit the State's dentists. Under the leadership of Dr. Maurice Miles, immediate past president, the Biosaftey and Infection Control Committee, chaired by Dr. Alberto Alejandro and myself, organized a program where the Board will conduct a voluntary CDC inspection of 50 dental offices at no charge and with no disciplinary ramifications. Notice of the program was sent to all licensed dentists. Interest in the program was so great that registration closed in just one day.

As a private practitioner, there have been times when I have found my knowledge of the dental laws to be very beneficial. As licensees to whom the public has placed their trust, it behooves us to know the State's laws and regulations. This was my motivation for creating the E-Newsletter series for the Board. To further expand on that series, and also provide information to those licensees who do not have electronic access, the Board will occasionally publish and mail a print newsletter as well. The frequency will be less often due to the prohibitive costs.

I have tried to make this edition of the Newsletter as informative and relevant as possible. - You must complete your continuing education requirements by December 31st of the year preceding your license renewal.
- The Board is hosting a free Webinar for the Pharmacology continuing education requirement on its website.
- Lack of adequate record keeping is a violation of the Maryland dental laws.
- The Board's anesthesia and sedation regulations have recently been amended.

THE DENTAL BOARD'S MISSION

The Dental Board is a regulatory body whose sole mission is to protect the public and promote quality health care in the field of dentistry.

The Board of Dental Examiners protects the citizens of Maryland by:

 Licensing and regulating the practice of dentistry, dental hygiene, and dental radiation technology.

The Board fulfills this mandate by reviewing every initial application that is sent to the Board. All candidates for licensure must have the necessary educational credentials and work related experience.

During fiscal year 2015, the Board issued licenses to 2818 dentists, 1816 hygienists and 5860 radiation technologists.

2. Resolving complaints against licensees who may have violated the Dental Practice Act and its regulations.

The Board receives approx. 300 complaints each year. The Board investigates each complaint that alleges facts which if true, would constitute a violation of the dental laws. Outcomes of board actions include closing the complaint, writing a letter of education or an advisory letter wherein the licensee is informed of shortcomings in their practice, to formal charges after the opportunity for a hearing, and revocation of a license if warranted.

 Setting standards for the practice of dentistry, dental hygiene and dental radiation technology that reflect new and emergent developments in the profession through legislation and regulation.

Attending Dental Board meetings is a good way to stay up-to-date on Board actions. The public is invited to the Board's open session meetings on the first Wednesday of each month. Also, visit us at dhmh. md.gov/dental to learn more about the Board.

I am currently serving my second 4 year term on the board. I also served as the president of the board for two years. It has been a great pleasure and honor and I would like to express my appreciation to all of the Board members who contributed a great deal of personal time to develop the following programs.

Being charged with protecting the public, the Board constantly refines its approach in response to current events and in anticipation of future needs.

Compliance with the dental laws is accomplished through enforcement actions after a complaint is made, since by law our system is complaint driven. During the past two years, the Board has augmented its enforcement actions with outreach and continuing education programs.

The following are the activities of the Maryland State Board of Dental Examiners from 2012-2014.

- 1. Legislative: Standard of Care, Dispensing Modifications, Recordkeeping (implementation for both paper and electronic), Pharmacology continuing education requirement (as a respond to a request of the Office of National Drug Control Policy to the American Association of Dental Boards).
- Increased Committee Activities: Infection Control and Biosafety (CDC Work Group and meeting with CDC Experts); Pharmacology Work Group and meeting with Pharmacology Experts specifically in the field of dentistry from the state of Maryland; Triage Procedural and Sanctioning Guidelines; Informal Meetings.
- 3. Outreach: Board Retreat; Meeting with Peer Review; Expert Training Class; University of Maryland Meetings (Faculty Licensure; Coordination of Care); Pharmacology Continuing Education Course; Developing Pharmacology Online Course.
- 4. Procedural/Governance: By-Laws Update; Initiated Code of Conduct; Unauthorized Practice/ Professional Responsibility Work Group; Compounding Work Group.

It is noteworthy to mention that Dr. Maurice Miles, immediate past-president and Dr. Ron Moser, president, contributed greatly to the implementation of "Standard of Care" legislation. With the new leadership, I am confident that the Maryland State Board of Dental Examiners will continue in its quest to protect the public.

I would like to express my appreciation to Dr. Ali Behnia, our newsletter and e-mail blast editor, who invested and continues to invest so many hours of his time to maintain a line of communication with our licensees.

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Dental Auxiliary Duties



The Maryland State Board of Dental Examiners has regulations regarding duties performed by dental auxiliary personnel. Allowing auxiliary staff (dental assistants, dental radiation technologists, and dental hygienists) to perform duties beyond their scope of practice is a violation of the dental laws.

Child Support License Suspension Program

By law, the Board cannot issue a new license to an applicant who is under a court order to pay child support and has past due arrears amounting to more than 120 days. Further, the Board is obligated to suspend an active license if notified by the Department of Social Services that a licensee is in arrears with child support payments. During the suspension, the licensee is prohibited from practicing. In addition, if a license is suspended, the suspension is public information. Once a payment plan has been worked out and the Board receives confirmation of such, the license is reinstated.
