## MDH introduces the IAC

On August 3, 2021, MDH established the Office of Internal Controls and Audit Compliance (IAC), a new departmental office tasked with helping to ensure that MDH operational units comply with legal, regulatory, and policy requirements, and promptly address internal control weaknesses identified in audits or other reviews. The IAC divisions include Audit Follow-Up, Audit Liaison, Compliance and Privacy, the Institutional Review Board, and Operations, Technology, and Risk Assessment. The IAC was created to manage certain responsibilities previously handled by the Office of the Inspector General (OIG), which has transformed due to recent legislation.

# What does the IAC do?

The IAC performs the following for MDH: Serves as liaison between MDH units and the Office of Legislative Audits (OLA) and all other external audit organizations Conducts follow-up reviews of audit-related corrective actions Receives and reviews allegations regarding employee conduct and other compliance issues •Tracks and reports on MDH compliance with secondary employment and financial disclosure requirements Receives and reviews potential violations of the MDH privacy policy and the Health Information Portability & Accountability Act (HIPAA) Coordinates the activities of the MDH IRB

•STILL have access to the MDH's IT, Budget, Human Resources, Police, Procurement, and Support Services.

• STILL maintain a physical location within the Department.

•NOW have an Inspector General that is appointed by the Governor, Attorney General, and Treasurer, and confirmed by the Senate.
