**ORDER LIFTING SUSPENSION OF REGISTRATION**  
**TO PRACTICE MASSAGE THERAPY**

On May 10, 2014, the Maryland Board of Chiropractic and Massage Therapy Examiners (the "Board") issued an Order of Registration Suspension for Delinquent Child Support ("Order of Suspension") against Bridget A. Myers, RMP, Registration No. R01594 (the "Respondent"). The Board suspended the Respondent's registration to practice as a registered massage practitioner due to her delinquent child support payments upon a request for the Montgomery County Office of Child Support Enforcement of the Maryland Department of Human Resources (the "Administration"), pursuant to Md. Code Ann., Fam. Law, § 10-119.3e(2)(i)(2012 Repl. Vol.).

On or about May 28, 2014, the Board received a Notice to Reinstate the Respondent's registration from the Administration. Pursuant to the Maryland Chiropractic Act, Maryland Code Ann., Health Occ., §§ 3-101 et seq. (2012 Repl. Vol.), the Respondent otherwise qualifies for a registration.

Therefore, pursuant to Md. Code Ann., Fam. Law, § 10-119.3(k), on this 29<sup>th</sup> day of May, 2014, by the Maryland Board of Chiropractic and Massage Therapy Examiners, it is hereby:

**ORDERED** that the suspension of the registration to practice as a registered massage practitioner in Maryland held by Bridget A. Myers, Registration No. R01594, is **LIFTED**; and it is further

**ORDERED** that this is a Final Order of the Maryland Board of Chiropractic and Massage Therapy Examiners and, as such, is a public document pursuant to Md. Code Ann., State Gov't, §§ 10-617(h).
