2. Scope of Practice Inquiry- Leona Odemena, DPM

• Is it unethical to treat a family member?

The Board's position is that it is not unethical to treat a family member; however, facts of a particular circumstance may result in a conflict that may preclude the appropriateness of familial treatment. Medical records for family members must also be maintained as required of any other patient.

• Is it unethical to treat a family member and bill for services?

The Podiatry Act (statute) does not prohibit and is silent regarding the treatment of family members, thus this becomes a personal decision; however, some third party payers may prohibit payment for treatment of family members.

• If it is unethical to treat a family member, what is the allowable distance of the family relationship to treat? (ex. Cousin, niece/nephew)

The above answers apply to this question as well.
