December/Early January 2022

Review period of HERC Pathways proposals by CHRC

- **The CHRC will convene a Review Committee comprised of CHRC Commissioners and staff to review the proposals that are received and issue recommendations to the full CHRC for consideration to present at future meeting of the CHRC.**

Mid-January 2022

CHRC meeting to receive recommendations from CHRC Review Committee on top-scoring HERC Pathway proposals recommended to present at the next CHRC meeting in early February

Early February 2022

CHRC meeting to receive presentations from HERC Pathways applicants invited to present

- **Following these presentations, the CHRC Commissioners are expected to issue grant award decisions**

Mid-February 2022

CHRC issues second legislative report to Governor and General Assembly that summarizes the Pathways grantees awarded by the CHRC Commissioners

- **Second report to be submitted after grant award decisions are made by the CHRC Commissioners in February 2022 (need to request extension/permission from legislature)**
