Item One

The Commission held an informal meeting with the Regional Directors and Director of Operations of a large dialysis organization who responded to questions posed by Donna Adcock, Eva Schwartz, and the Commissioners concerning deficiency findings and compliance issues related to inadequate Clinical Oversight, Personnel Staffing, Infection Control, and Water and Dialysate Quality. The executives from the facilities reported on their Plans of Correction and improvements they intend to implement at each of their facilities to assure full compliance with all State and federal regulations governing standard of care. After discussion, the Commissioners expressed concerns about the lack of clinical oversight and staffing, and provided guidance for how to assure appropriate standard of care.
