Licensing Process for Initial Applicants and Renewals

To provide a single point of entry and increase efficiency, the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene has designated the Office of Health Care Quality (OHCQ) to have primary responsibility for processing all initial and renewal applications for DDA providers.

Effective April 1, 2014, all initial and renewing applicants shall submit their materials directly to OHCQ for review and approval. The following documents are available on the OHCO website to assist in the licensing process:
