ORDER OF TERMINATION OF PROBATION

On or about April 10, 2020, the Maryland State Board of Examiners in Optometry (the “Board”) issued a Final Decision and Order (the “04/10/2020 Order”), which, among other things, placed Thomas Azman, O.D. (the “Petitioner”), License No. TA 0678, on probation for a minimum of one (1) year, subject to the probationary terms and conditions described in the 04/10/2020 Order.¹

By letter dated April 5, 2021, the Petitioner petitioned the Board to terminate the probation upon his License. The Board considered this Petition and has decided to terminate the probation imposed by the 04/10/2020 Order, based on the Petitioner’s satisfactory compliance with the terms and conditions of probation in the 04/10/2020 Order.


Wherefore, it is hereby:

ORDERED that the probation and all associated terms and conditions imposed upon Thomas Azman, O.D., License No. TA 0678, as set forth in the 04/10/2020 Order are hereby **LIFTED** and **TERMINATED** and those terms and conditions have no further force and effect; and it is further
